

Quick and effective ways to rid your home of pollen.

- Keep windows closed.
- Mixing warm water and dish soap creates a simple yet effective cleaning solution to remove pollen.
- For a more natural route, vinegar mixed with water is • another great choice.
- Use a **damp cloth to clean** tops of doors, windowsills and window frames.
- Vacuuming your floors, drapes, and pillows

Patios and Decks:

- Mix warm water and dish soap. Scrub with . a brush then rinse thoroughly.
- Use a garden hose to spray each surface, including furniture. For deep cleans, follow with a wet rag doused in a lather of dish soap and give the items a good scrub. Towel dry furniture, be sure to air dry your cushions.

Pollen is important, but it's a nuisance!

According to the Centers for Disease Control, "Pollen is the grains or tiny seeds of flowering plants, trees, and grasses. These seeds can be carried on the wind and can cause various symptoms, or none at all, in individuals who are exposed to them. "

According to most of us with allergies, pollen can be a nightmare. The best we can do is limit our contact with pollen. Avoid lawn mowing, weed pulling and other gardening chores that stir up allergens, without wearing protective gear. Remove clothing you've worn outside and shower to rinse pollen from your skin and hair. Don't hang laundry outside, pollen can stick to sheets and towels. Stay indoors in the morning, if possible, grass pollens mainly circulate in the morning.

According to the allergy asthma network, across the United States, **May** is typically the worst month for allergy sufferers. Most of the country sees elevated pollen counts, in May. The lowest pollen count is towards late afternoon into the early evening. This can be relative because when the pollen count is very high, even though it decreases as the day progresses, there will still be a relatively high level of pollen still held in the air.
